1st Kup (Black tip) to Black Belt

Theory

Brown represents the tree taking solid root in the earth as technique becomes proficient. Black is the opposite of white: signifying maturity and proficiency, also symbolising the wearer's imperviousness to darkness and fear.

Hyung

Chung-Mu (30 movements)

Chung Mu was the name given to the great Admiral Yi Sun-Sin of the Yi Dynasty. He was reputed to have invented the first armoured battleship (Kobukson) in 1592, which was the precursor of the present day submarine. The reason why this pattern ends in a left hand attack is to symbolise his regrettable death, having no chance to show his unrestrained potentiality checked by his forced reservation of his loyalty to the King.
